We are grateful for your time and believe this day will help you whether you are already deeply involved in the foster care, kinship care & adoption community, or if this is your first exploratory step.


WHAT IS MIFAM?

ETC is a dynamic network of programs aimed at increasing access to holistic care for individuals, families, and communities.

As an ambassador organization of Karyn Purvis Institute of Child Development (KPICD) Safe and Secure TN, offers multidisciplinary training to caregivers and professionals supporting children who have experienced adversity, trauma, and loss. The research-based and empirically validated intervention, Trust-Based Relational Intervention (TBRI®), is utilized to guide their training and consulting services. Safe & Secure TN collaborates with organizations and stakeholders across communities to build capacity for trauma-informed care across systems.
